



WHERE MARYLAND STANDS: PLANNING FOR 5G

A requirement for Maryland communities to be 5G capable is the deployment of small cells, antennas often installed on right-of-way infrastructure, like utility poles and streetlights, that are connected by fiber optic cable. Some counties in Maryland have enacted legislation to allow for the deployment of small cells, while others are at risk of falling behind.



STATEWIDE LEGISLATION

Surrounding states including Pennsylvania, New Jersey, Delaware, Virginia, West Virginia, North Carolina, and D.C. have introduced or enacted statewide small cell legislation.
